1. Each child needs a waiver signed by a parent or guardian before being allowed to fish.
2. Time slots are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Once a time slot has been assigned, it cannot be changed.
3. No substitutions of T-shirt sizes the day of the event. If no size circled, adult small will be provided.
4. Kids need to arrive 30 minutes before their designated fishing time.
5. All fishing gear and bait will be provided. No personal fishing gear will be allowed.
6. Once registration has been completed, families will go to the rod & reel pick-up station.
7. At the beginning of their fishing session, families may then go to the fishing spot of their choice. Life jackets will be provided and are required on all fishing docks, youth and adults, no exceptions.
8. Even though over 9,000 fish have been planted for this event, fishing can be slow for a variety of reasons, such as water temperature. If a child has not caught a fish, please contact a guide for help.
9. Parents are encouraged to help their children fish, but the child is the one that should be fishing.
10. Once the limit of 3 fish is caught, each participant will need to leave the fishing area.
11. **Catch and release will not be allowed.**
12. At the end of your fishing session please exit quickly to make room for the next session.
