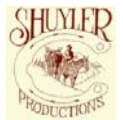

Event Rules and Guidelines

1. Kids will need to arrive 30 minutes before their designated fishing time to check in and pick up their Rod and Reel.
2. Once registration has been completed families will go to the staging area to wait until the beginning of their fishing session.
3. At the beginning of their fishing session, families may then go to the spot of their choice. Due to limited fishing area, please limit number of non-fishing family members out on the pathway around the pond. Non-fishing family members are welcome to sit up on the hill or in the bleacher area to stay safely out of the way and watch.
4. The goal is for each participant to catch a fish and the partners that make this event happen work hard to achieve that goal, yet there are circumstances beyond our control that may cause a minority of participants to not catch a fish. Contact a volunteer guide in an orange vest for further assistance.
5. Parents are encouraged to help their child(ren) fish. However the child is the one that should be fishing.
6. No dogs or bicycles or strollers will be allowed in the fishing area, for safety considerations.
7. Once the event limit of 2 fish is caught, each child needs to leave the fishing area and proceed to the cleaning station. Catch and release will not be allowed and will result in immediate departure from the fishing area.
8. Parking is limited and if possible, use of community transit or carpooling is encouraged.
9. Registration form must be turned in to the Yakima Greenway Foundation no later than 5:00pm April 30th. This program fills up rapidly, so register early.
10. Time slots are assigned on a first come, first serve basis. Once a registration form is completed or online registration is concluded, these assignments cannot be changed.
11. A parent or legal guardians signature is required for any child to participate in this program, no exceptions.
